Neighbourhood Plan – Elspeth Clements

- A plan writer (Alex Munro) has been appointed and £3000 allocated for writing costs. AM will report back in mid February with a view to having a fairly final draft plan by February 24. An important priority is to pull together all the policy statements, which are currently distributed across the sections of the plan.
- The consultation period with the Highgate community is planned for March 24 to May 5, to complete before the local elections in May.
- It now appears that the plan needs a sustainability assessment; Adam Brown (who has replaced Amy Tyler Jones) will check on what is required.
- A further meeting with Haringey on Site Allocations is planned (January 23) and a number of potential development or open space sites were discussed. It was noted that a policy is needed on height of building for potential development sites.
- MH has rewritten the policy on the fringes of the Heath.
