5. Chair's Report (AP)

- AP had met Ravinder Dhanjal, Haringey's dynamic new lead for High Streets. She will put ARAG colleagues in touch with her.
- Exciting plans for Haringey being Borough of Culture in 2027, which Archway Road could be a part of.
- AP met with Cllr Anna Wright to discuss the aftermath of the abandonment of the DPHN scheme - councillors and officials are meeting with Highgate West Hill and Chetwynd Road Residents. AP and MMK were going straight from meeting to a meeting of local groups from Archway, Dartmouth Park and Highgate interested in forming an umbrella group to promote positive ideas around quieter, safer, greener streets.
- Highgate Festival was a brilliant success with two events in Pond Square + a Community Bike Ride, amidst much else. It will definitely continue for another two years with a really big splash in 2027 to be a part of Haringey's Borough of Culture.
- 6. DG and GC reported back from the Archway Road Action Group (ARAG) – they had five sub groups:
 - Flytipping, ASB, shoplifting and litter
 - Placemaking (AP advised that this group needed to link up with Highgate Festival and Boogaloo)
 - Road Safety (Joanne McCartney organising a meeting with TfL)
 - Shop Preservation
- Greening now delegated to HS Guerilla Gardeners Planning a strategy, website and bank account
 - 7. Highgate School developments update: Due to a mix up re venue, Francis Wilkinson missed the meeting but sent this report:

The substantially amended (and it is generally agreed, improved) plans for the Mallinson Centre, which is the first of the School's projects to be commenced, have been consulted on and it is hoped that there will be some further amendments as a result of comments made in the consultation meeting. The application is expected to be sent to Haringey in the autumn, with work to start next year. A consultation has also taken place in relation to the
